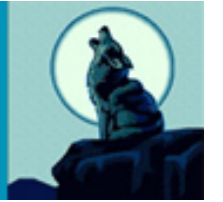

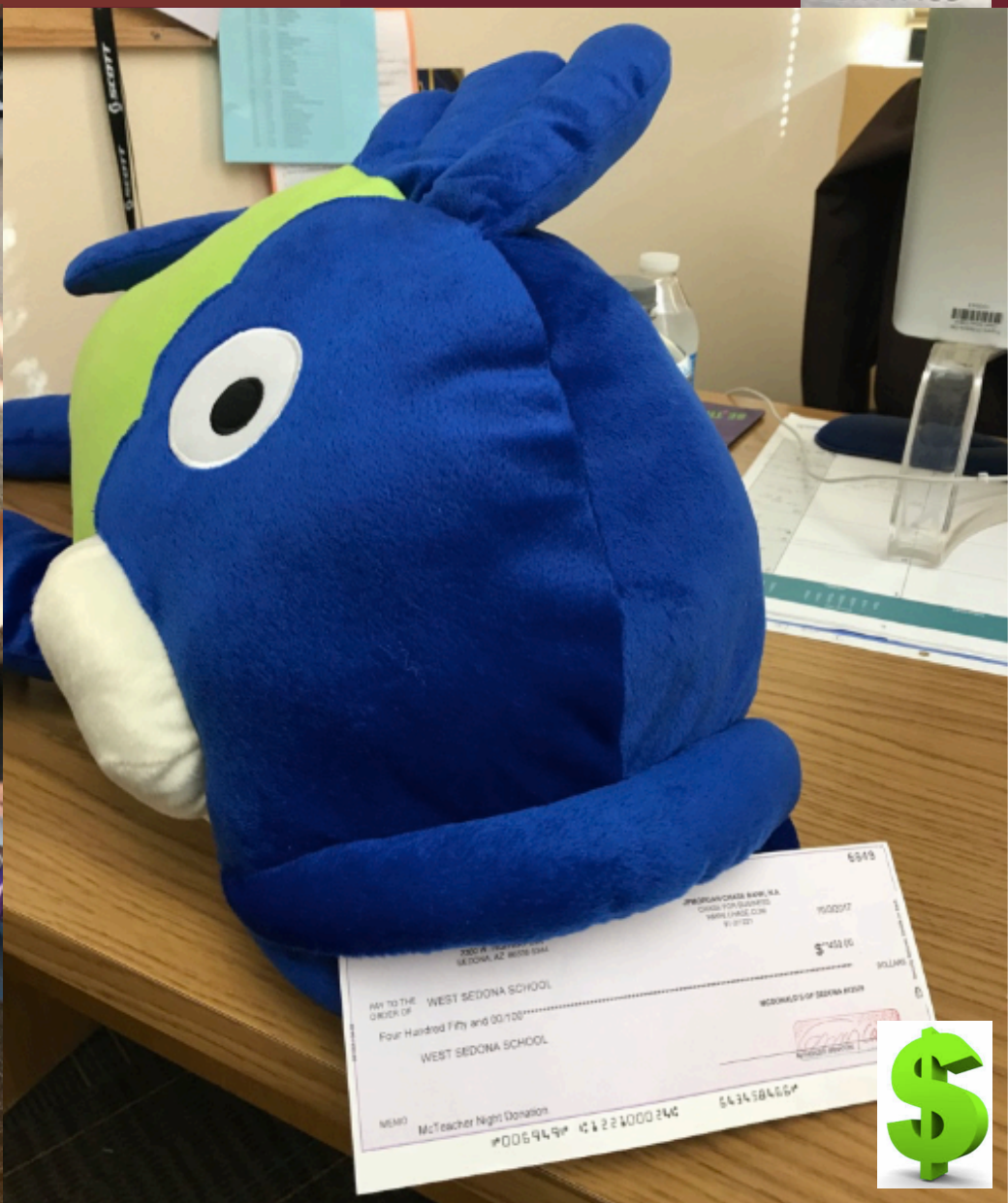

STEM Student Profile with K-6 students

**Rollercoasters:** Students will explore the concepts of gravity, motion, and energy while experimenting with marbles and tubes to design their own rollercoasters.

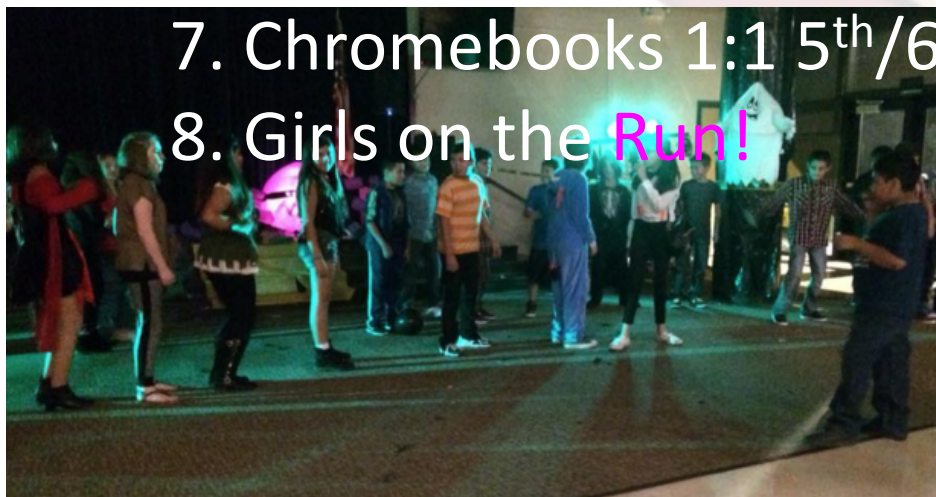
**Chemysteries:** Students encounter fundamental chemical principles, explore states of matter and investigate the mysterious changes that occur during a chemical reaction.

**I.D.E.A.:** Invention, design and exploration adventure! Students will work together to design a ramp that will slow down a bouncy ball as it rolls to the end. They will use the Engineering Design Process to understand concepts such as simple machines, energy transfer, conservation and forces.



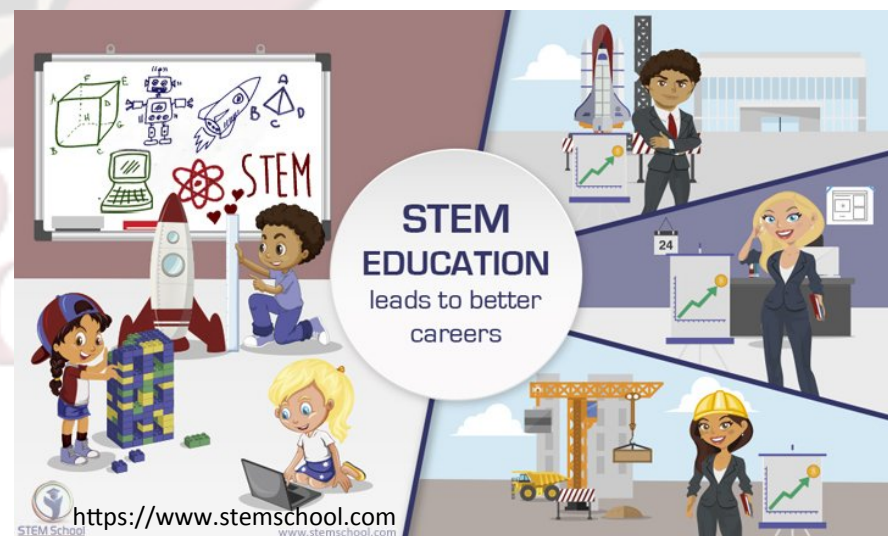

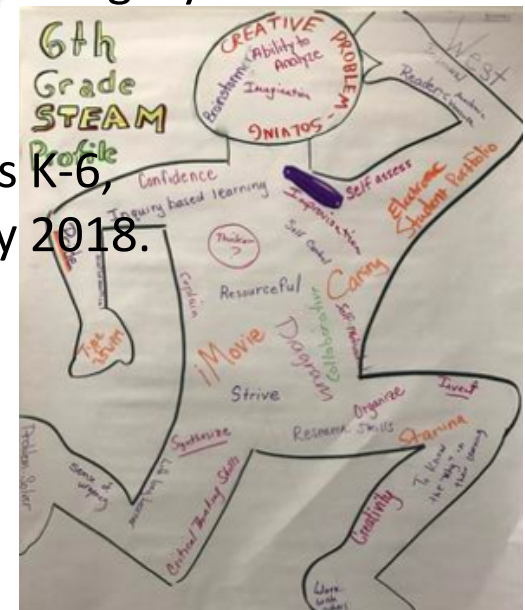

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## PROP 301 Goals

2. Using Galileo Benchmarking and Data, I will show growth in 95 % of students at 5 % rate or higher. This will be reflected from Test One to Test Two.
- 3a. By December 2017, 90% of students enrolled in Physical Education at SRRHS will be Certified by the EVERFI AlcoholEDU course (endorsed by MATFORCE).
- 3b. 65% of all students (Spanish I and II) will score 75% or higher on a comprehensive course exam to include written, listening and oral components to show competency.

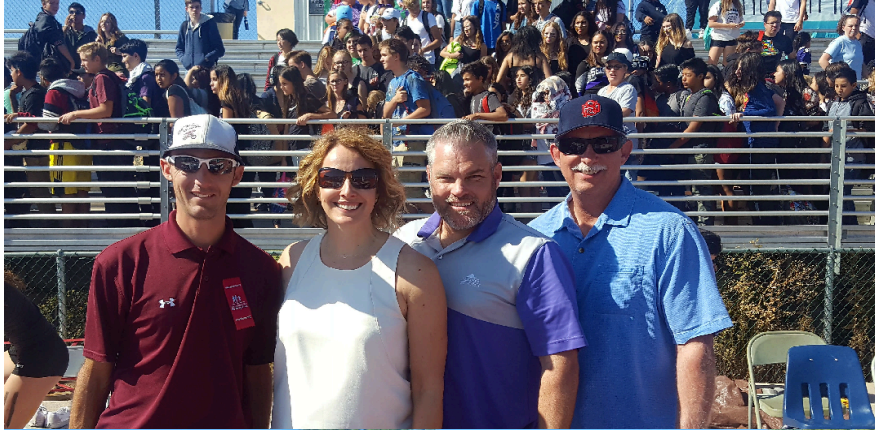
