

Rollercoasters: Students will explore the concepts of gravity, motion, and energy while experimenting with marbles and tubes to design their own rollercoasters.


Chemysteries: Students encounter fundamental chemical principles, explore states of matter and investigate the mysterious changes that occur during a chemical reaction.

I.D.E.A.: Invention, design and exploration adventure! Students will work together to design a ramp that will slow down a bouncy ball as it rolls to the end. They will use the Engineering Design Process to understand concepts such as simple machines, energy transfer, conservation and forces.
