Open Session

<u>Agenda Item:</u> The Board will be presented with the results of the community e-survey related to the search for a new District superintendent.

Discussion: The Board directed the Arizona School Boards Association to conduct an e-survey for the purpose of gathering information from the community related to the position of District superintendent. This agenda item provides an opportunity for the Board to review and discuss the results of the survey.

Agenda Item: The Governing Board will discuss information presented by the Arizona School Boards Association (ASBA) pertaining to the screening process of applicants for the position of District Superintendent.

Discussion: The Governing Board is in the process of seeking a new District Superintendent.

To assist with this process the Board employed the services of ASBA. This agenda item provides the Board an opportunity to receive information and ask questions regarding the applicant screening process.

Open Session

<u>Agenda Item</u>: The Governing Board will discuss applicants for the position of District Superintendent and may consider directing the Arizona School Boards Association (ASBA) to invite specific applicants to interview for the position.

Discussion: ASBA advertised and collected applications for the position of District Superintendent on behalf of the Governing Board. This agenda item provides the Board an opportunity to discuss submitted applications for the position. The Board may consider directing ASBA to invite specific applicants, on the Board's behalf, for an initial interview with the Board. Names of applicants for a position are not subject to disclosure prior to becoming one of a defined list of finalists for the position. Hence, applicant names will not be released at this time.

<u>Agenda Item:</u> The Governing Board will discuss the initial interview process and may consider directing the Arizona School Board Association (ASBA) to construct the interview process and schedule with specific applicants identified by the Board for the position of District Superintendent.

Discussion: This agenda item provides the opportunity for the Board to discuss with an ASBA representative options related to the initial interview process. From this discussion the Board may consider directing ASBA to construct the interview process.

<u>Agenda Item:</u> The Governing Board will discuss areas of interest regarding questions to be used during the initial interviews and may consider directing the Arizona School Board Association (ASBA) to construct specific questions to be asked of applicants for the position of District Superintendent.

Discussion: A representative of ASBA will lead the Board through a discussion that is intended to provide focused direction related to initial interview questions to be asked of applicants. The Board may consider directing ASBA to construct specific questions to be used during the interview.

Agenda Item: The Governing Board will discuss options related to the configuration of finalist

interviews for the position of District Superintendent.

Discussion: A representative of ASBA will provide the Board with options related to the configuration of finalist interviews. At a future meeting of the Board direction may be given to ASBA related to the finalist interviews.

Agenda Item: The Governing Board will discuss and may consider the process for a finalist community forum related to the position of District Superintendent.

Discussion: A representative of the District will present an overview of a recommended process and schedule that is suggested for the finalist community forum.
