4. Discussion of Data

Ms. Ramirez led a discussion that included: rapid technological changes and challenges, bilingual education, using time and resources wisely, flexible learning pathways, cultural identity and adaptability, emotional learning, V'ACTE, innovative educational programs, and student preparedness for college. It was noted that meeting all needs is a challenge. Mr. Keller presented Arizona's overly complicated school-finance formula. Information

included: kindergarten funding, Prop. 301, projected budget deficits, 15% Override, challenges with real time funding, health insurance increases, Prop. 206 minimum wage increases, reduced grant and capital purchase funding, teacher salaries, enrollment trends, state equalization program, Community Foundations, charter schools, and upcoming budget discussions.
