



Sedona Community Pool Code of Conduct

Coaches, Supervisors and Contracted Parties

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All contracted and affiliated supervisors/coaches that oversee programs at the Sedona Community Pool agree to maintain wholesome supervisory conduct while representing their club, school or organization while on deck or at the pool facility.

All supervisors/coaches/contractors authorized to conduct programs at the Sedona Community Pool will adhere to the following guidelines:

General

1. Obey all posted pool rules and obey directions given from City of Sedona staff.
2. The pool office and first aid room are off limits to participants, coaches, parents, and spectators, with the exception of gaining emergency access to the AED.
3. Monitor and manage participants, coaches, parents and spectators to conduct themselves in a wholesome and safe manner.
4. Remain on deck during all times when participants are in the water. Supervise all participants until the last participant leaves the pool deck or facility.
5. Users will refrain from:
 - a. Using profanity
 - b. Eating on pool deck
 - c. Horseplay on deck
6. Adhere to the agreed upon program time frame by entering and exiting the water on time.
7. Pick up all equipment, water bottles, towels and trash generated by your participants, coaches, parents and spectators.
8. Team coaches are only allowed to coach team members who have reported to the location for their team's use. If a team member belongs to more than one team, the other coach is not to interfere while the team member is under the other coach's direction.
9. Team participants, coaches, parents and spectators, will be respectful to each other and additional users at the pool.

Specific to program: **Sedona Red Rock High School Swim Team** (hereafter referred to as Team)

Terms of Use:

1. Seasons and Practices defined as follows:
 - a. August 8 - 9, 2018
 - i. Agree to the use of eight (8) lanes, Wednesday and Thursday, between the hours of 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

b. August 10 through November 2, 2018

i. Agree to the use of six (6) lanes*, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

**Team understands that its use of the facility is non-exclusive and that separate lanes may be used concurrently with other teams as authorized by the City under a separate agreement.*

c. On days of Home Swim Meets, Sedona Red Rock High School Team will use all eight (8) lanes beginning at 2:30 p.m. Dates to be determined and submitted to the City of Sedona by no later than August 1, 2018.

2. Additional Rental Hours


a. 4:00 p.m., September 21, 2018, through 4:00 p.m., September 22, 2018 – 24 Hour Relay. Exclusive (private/closed to the public) pool use hours. Team will be responsible to ensure that the facility is returned in the same manner as when arriving.

3. During Team's use, swimmers will not be allowed on deck or in the water until a Team coach is on deck.

4. During Team's use, the Team is required to have two (2) individuals on deck with certifications in Lifeguard and CPR/First Aid issued by the American Red Cross or any nationally recognized organization, such as Starfish Aquatics Institute or Ellis & Associates.

5. Team is responsible to ensure that locker rooms and deck are clear, doors (locker rooms, first aid room and garage) and gates are locked, and facility is secure when leaving. During shared use hours, the last team to leave facility is responsible.

Failure to adhere to the rules outlined in this Code of Conduct and/or breach thereof could result in loss of facility usage.
