Karen McClelland gave an update on the AZ School Board Association Board of Directors retreat, including legislative priorities, a new online process to give input on those priorities, and potential partnerships with high school and college groups to improve student advocacy in the legislative process.

Superintendent Dearden gave an update on events, including legislative discussions on the Aggregate Expenditure Limit, National Honor Society inductions, the Teacherage Grant for affordable housing projects, the search for a new Student Representative to the Governing Board, and enrollment trends.

XII. Business Items and Presentations

A. Recognition of Student Representative Hunter White Denny Dearden Superintendent Dearden presented an award to Hunter White in recognition of his extraordinary commitment and service to the school board. Hunter thanked Superintendent Dearden and the School Board Members for the opportunity to serve. Governing Board members also expressed their admiration and thanks.

B. Overview of the Arizona General Education Credits (AGEC) partnership with Yavapai College to allow SOCUSD students to earn college credits at major Arizona universities

Deanna Hernandez and Megan Paquette

SOCUSD High School Counselor Deanna Hernandez and YCC Director of Early College & Promise Programs Megan Paquette gave an overview of the AGEC program, which would allow students to take up to 35 general education credits for college credit at NAU, U of A, or ASU. This is different than the current Early College Program because it is an opportunity for students to commit to fewer college courses or enter the program later. Superintendent Dearden noted that there could be costs for families, but donors have pledged \$20,000 to cover costs for interested students over the next few years. Courses could be taken online or in person during a student's senior year. Board members expressed appreciation for this creative solution to help students prepare for college.

ACTION ITEM: Discussion and possible action to approve the AGEC partnership with Yavapai College.

C. Universal CareerBuilder Adventure California Field Trip for 7th and 8th Grade Students

Middle school counselor Taryn Quenzer gave an overview of the proposed Universal CareerBuilder Adventure field trip to California. She addressed the quality of the trip provider, safety precautions, itinerary, alignment to standards, cost, and fundraising opportunities. Board members raised questions about affordability. Fundraising events, donations and partnerships with community organizations were discussed as possible ways to extend this opportunity to more students.
