Context



- Last ELA Curriculum adoption for K-5: Pearson (Savvas) Reading Street in 2016
- Savvas "Sunset" Reading Street in December 2021
 - o Digital Platform, Professional Development, Consumable Materials are no longer available


• Spring 2023

- A WSS ELA Curriculum Committee met to begin exploring potential curricular and supplemental options.
- o Surveyed teachers at WSS regarding ELA Curriculum needs and feedback on Reading Street.
- Met three times throughout the Spring; paused during district administration changes.

2023-2024 WSS Curriculum Committee

- **Committee Members:** Elizabeth Tavasci (Principal), Erin Gonzalez (Reading Specialist), Dani Beinfest (ELD Teacher), Mindy Zarlingo (Kindergarten Teacher), Maureen Barton (2nd Grade Teacher), and later joined by Karyl Goldsmith (SY 24-25 Director of Instruction/Curriculum)
- **Ongoing Meetings:** November 2023 February 2024
- Researched and reviewed curricular options
- **Collected Feedback** from WSS Teachers via PLC agendas and provided answers to teacher questions via email and staff meeting.
- Focused on goals for a curriculum to include:
 - Based on the Science of Reading; consistent; provides systematic teaching of reading skills; integrates social studies and science content; includes assessments, virtual components, easy to access materials, supports for ELL students, and can be differentiated for a range of student abilities.

Science Of Reading



Amplify CKLA Curriculum

- Comprehensive core curriculum for ELA for PreK-5
- Grounded in the *Science of Reading*
- Combines content-rich knowledge-building and research-based, systematically and explicitly taught foundational reading skills.
 - K-2 includes two daily lessons (60 minutes foundational skills, 60 minutes knowledge building)
 - o 3-5 includes 1 integrated daily lesson (120 minutes)
- Has been independently and rigorously reviewed (earned all green scores on EdReports)
- Digital resources for teachers' instruction and student use is included.
- An ELL companion curriculum is available.
- Is connected to our current benchmark assessments: Amplify mClass DIBELS
- Is an ADE approved Core Curriculum for MOWR (Move On When Reading)
 - o Is "Green" (Currently all green core curriculums are under regular review process per state statutes)



Recommendation and Next Steps

- The WSS Curriculum Committee unanimously voted to recommend **Amplify CKLA** for SOCUSD Board adoption.
- Next Step: Provide sample curricular materials of Amplify CKLA at District Office,
 West Sedona School and website for public review and comment for 60 days.
- During 60 Days: Gather/review feedback from public review, staff, etc.
- June 2024: 2nd Presentation to SOCUSD Board for potential vote and adoption of Amplify CKLA.
- If adopted by Board, SOCUSD would plan to use ESSER Funds to purchase Amplify CKLA.
