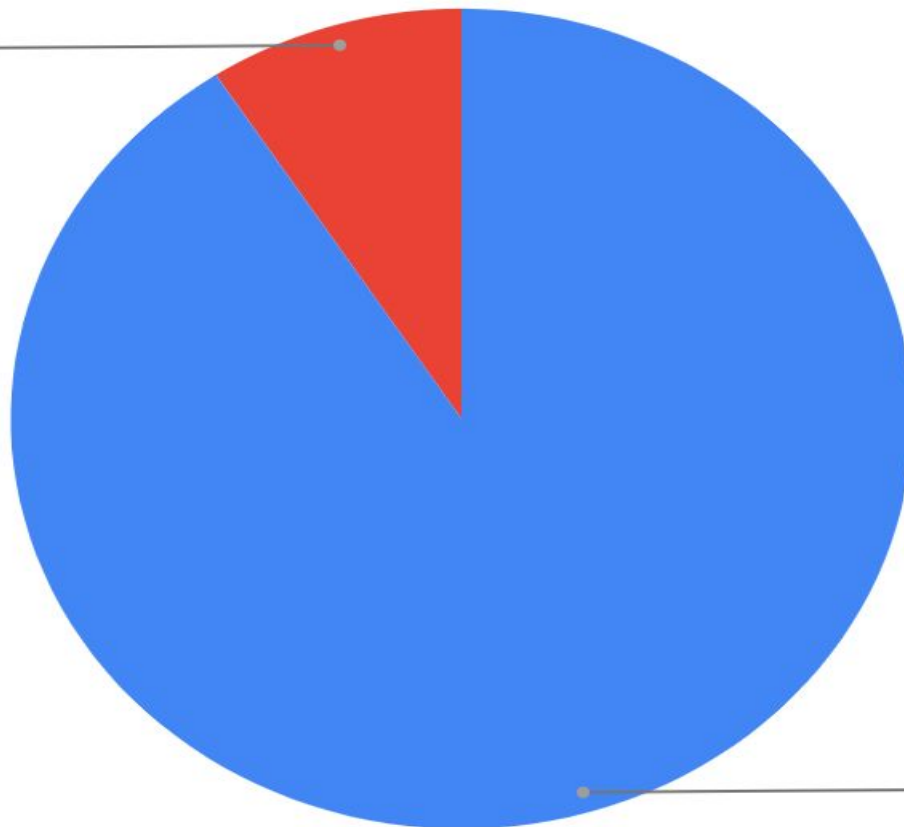

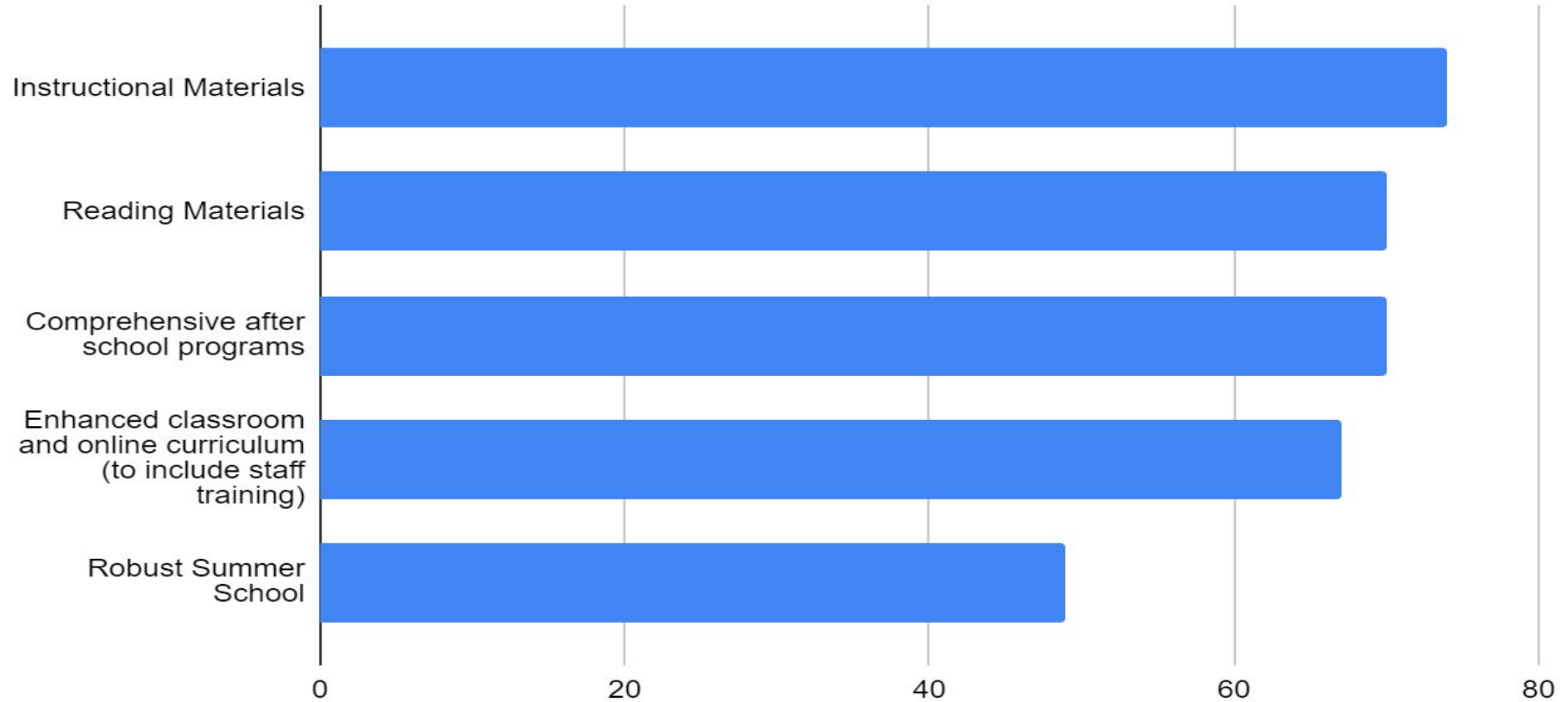

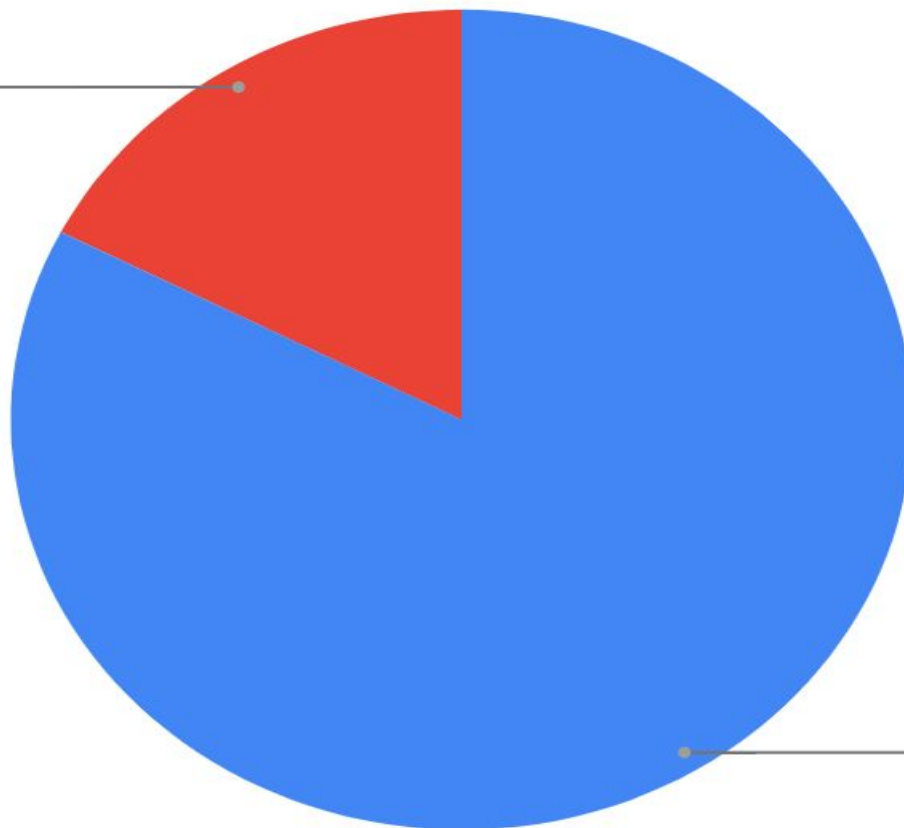

Somewhat/Not Important

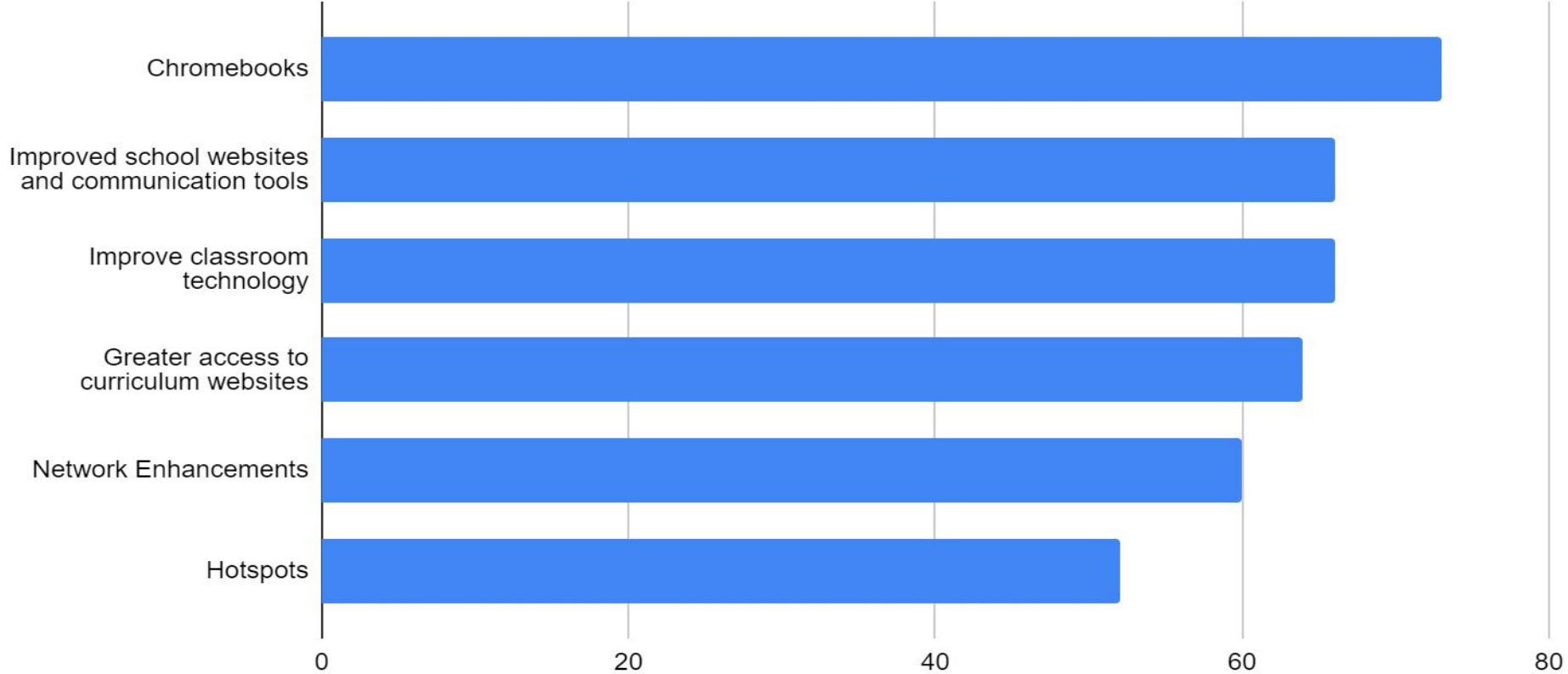

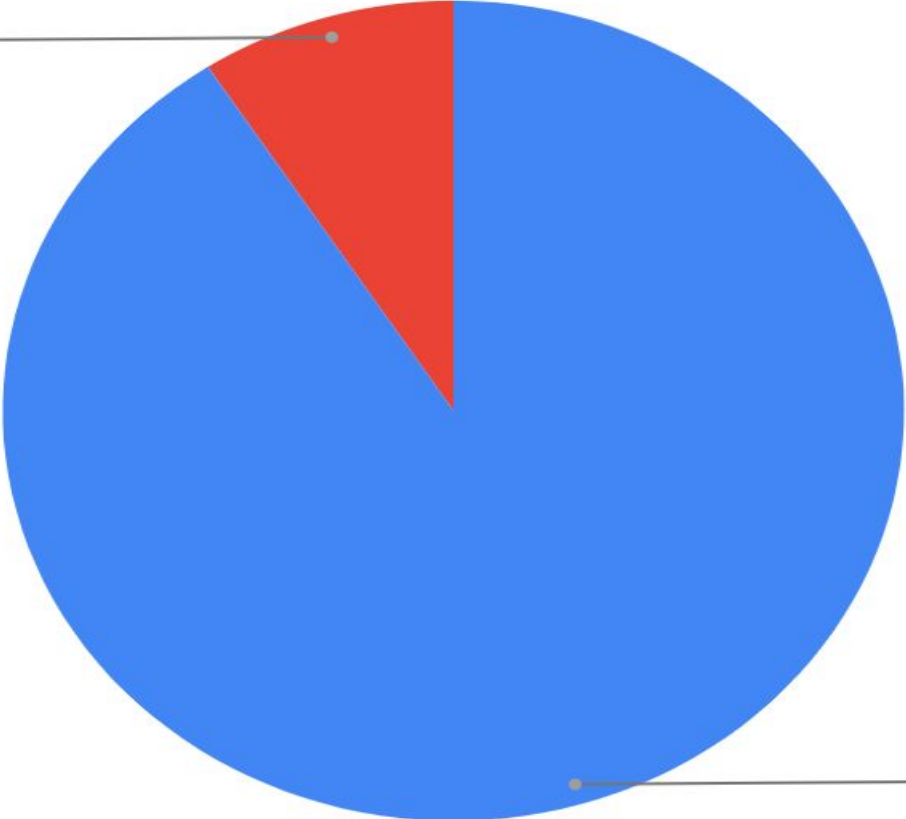

Somewhat/Not Important

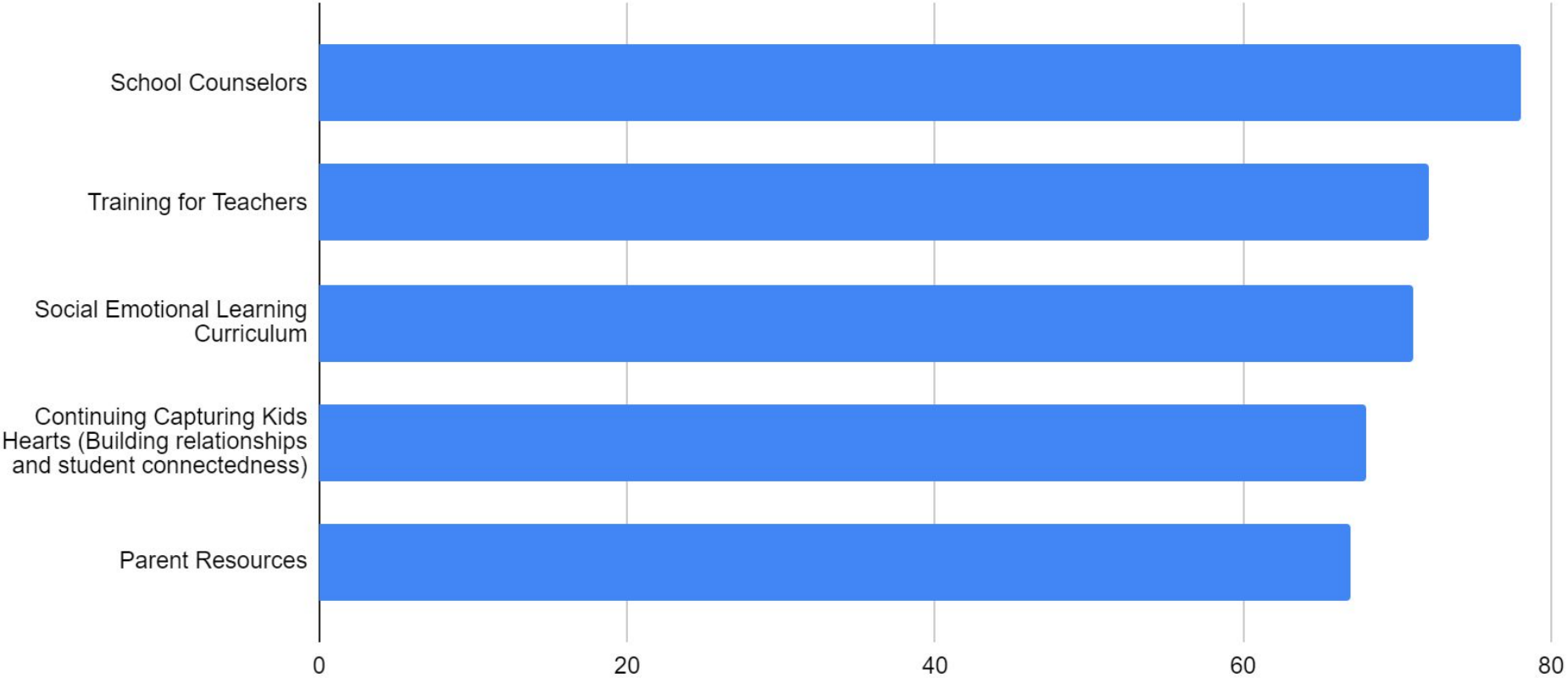

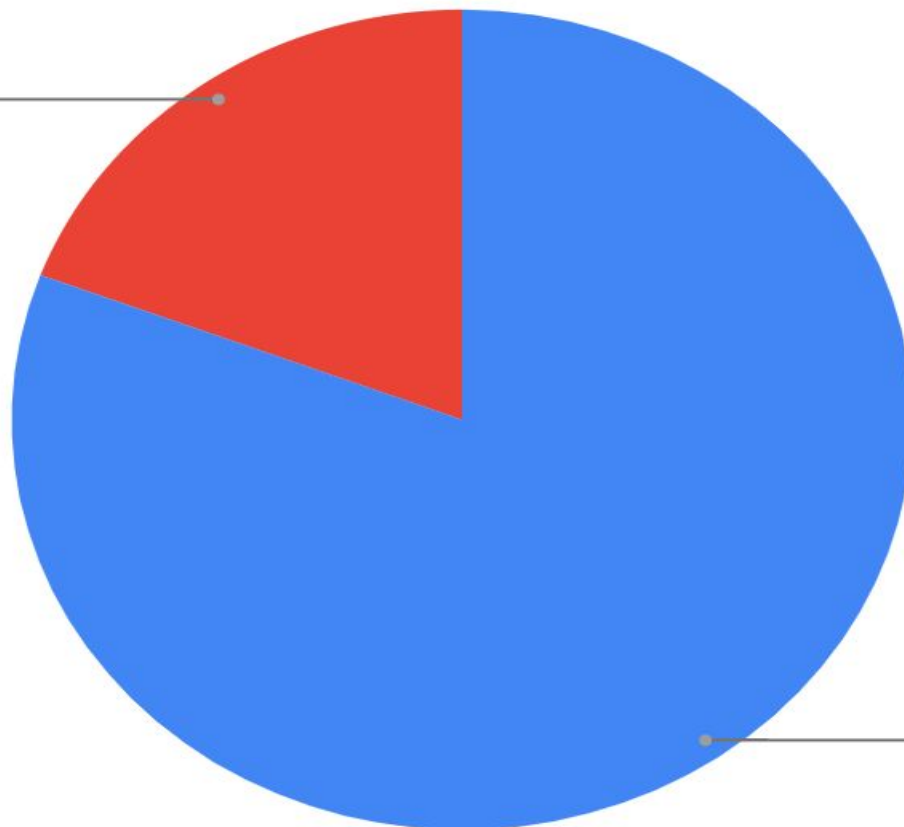

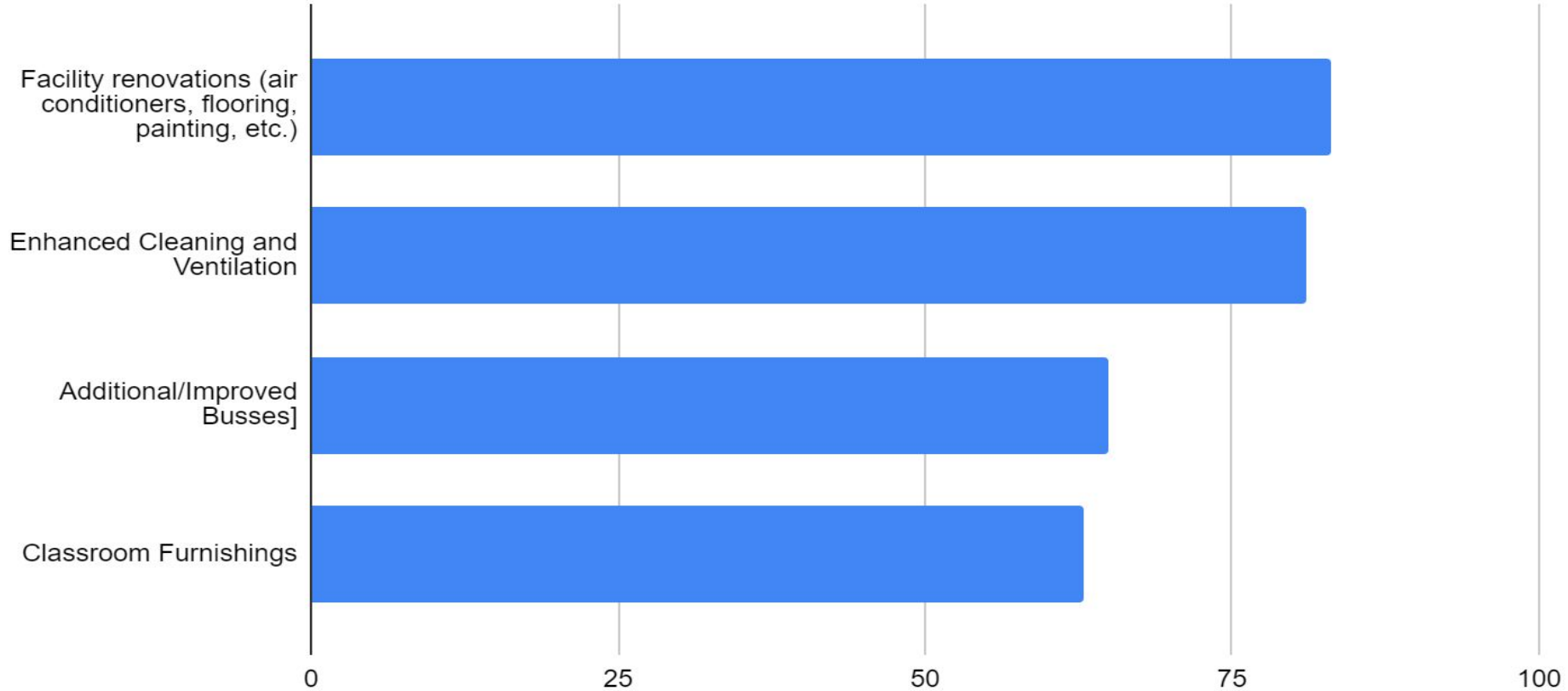

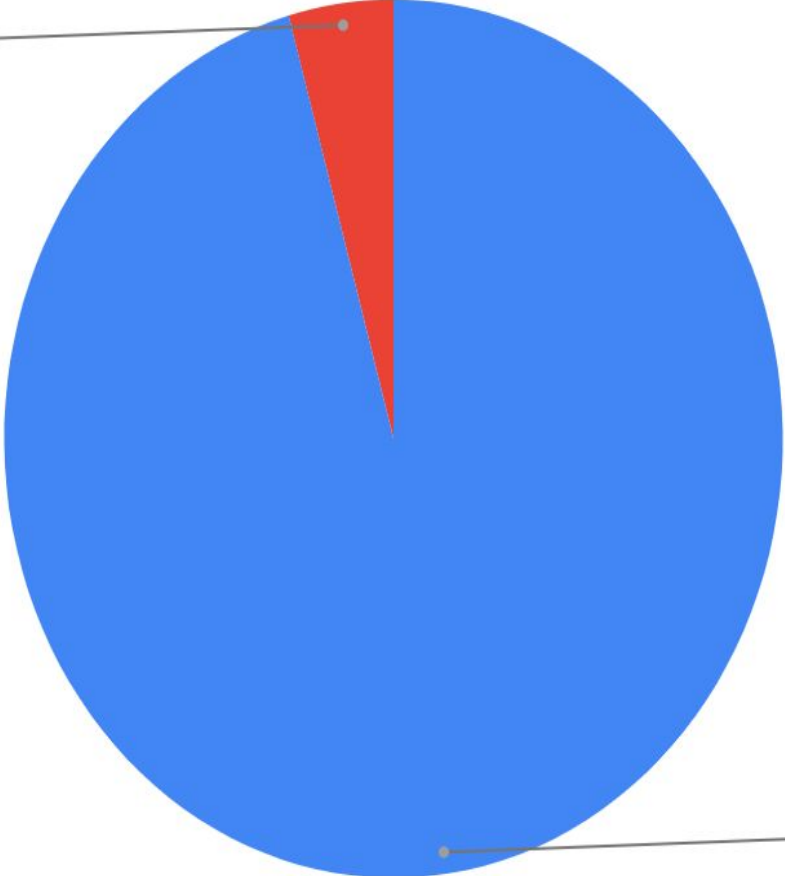

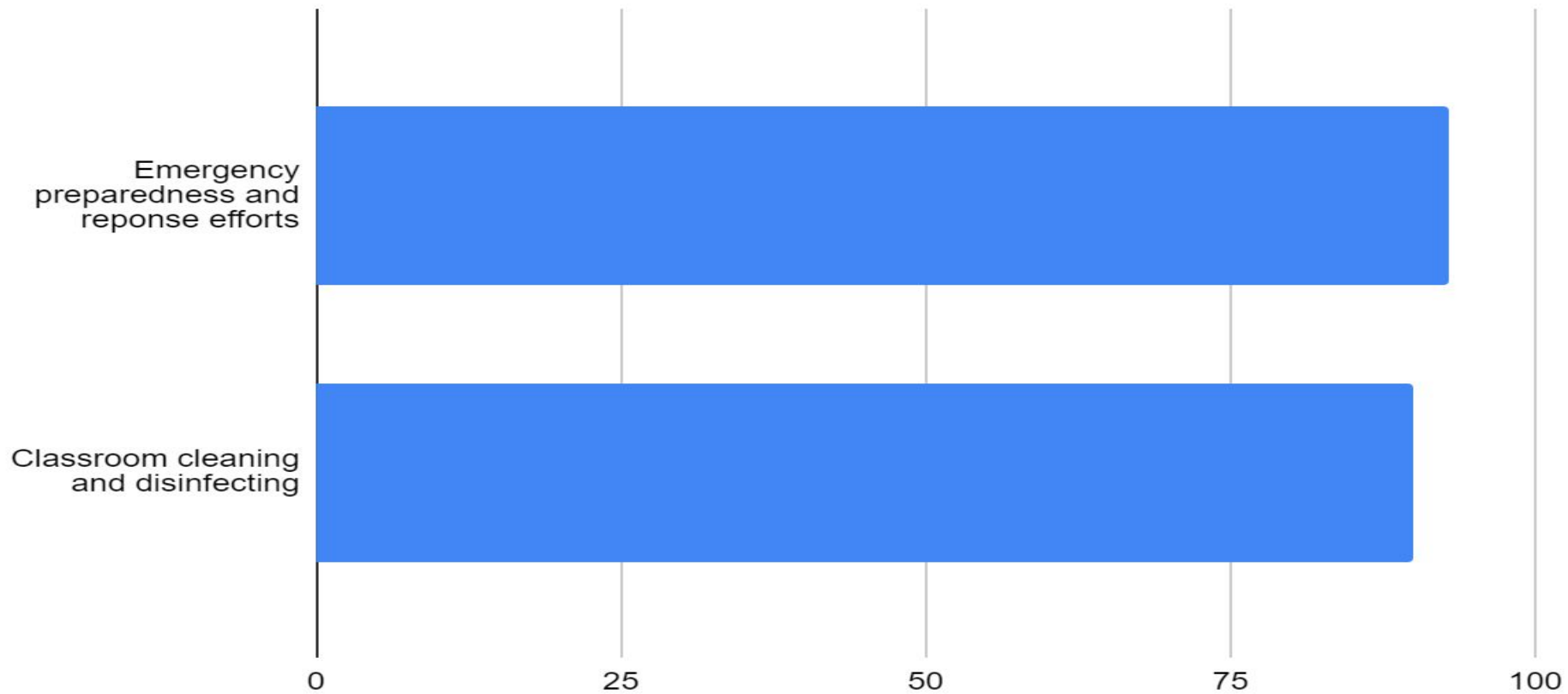
# Count of How important is investing in Safety overall?

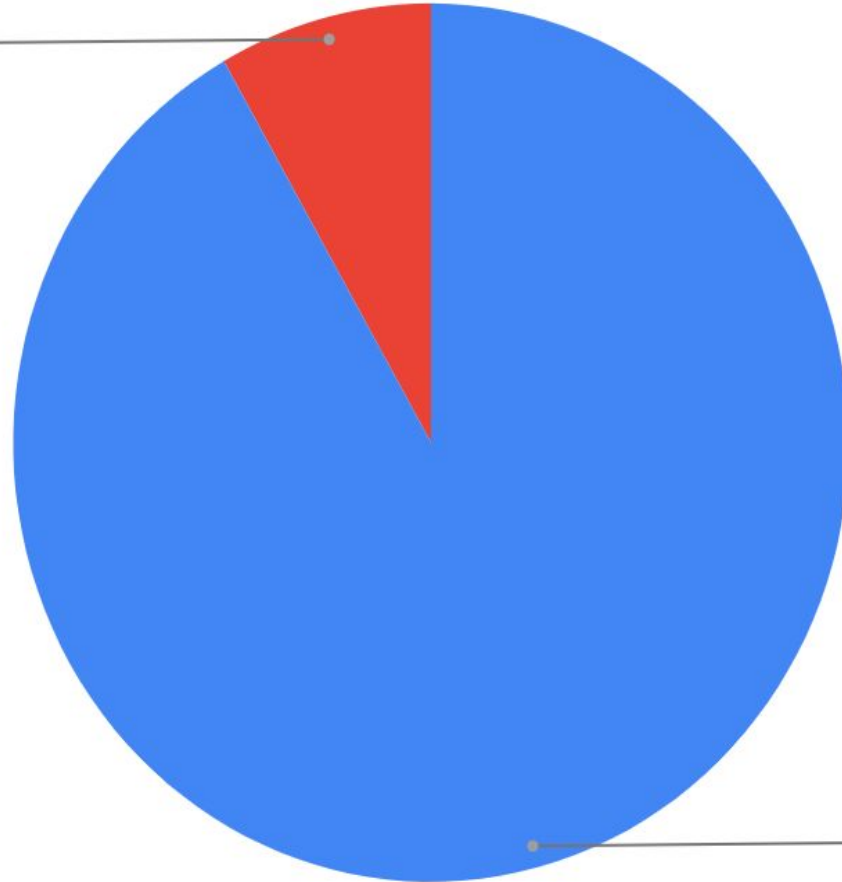

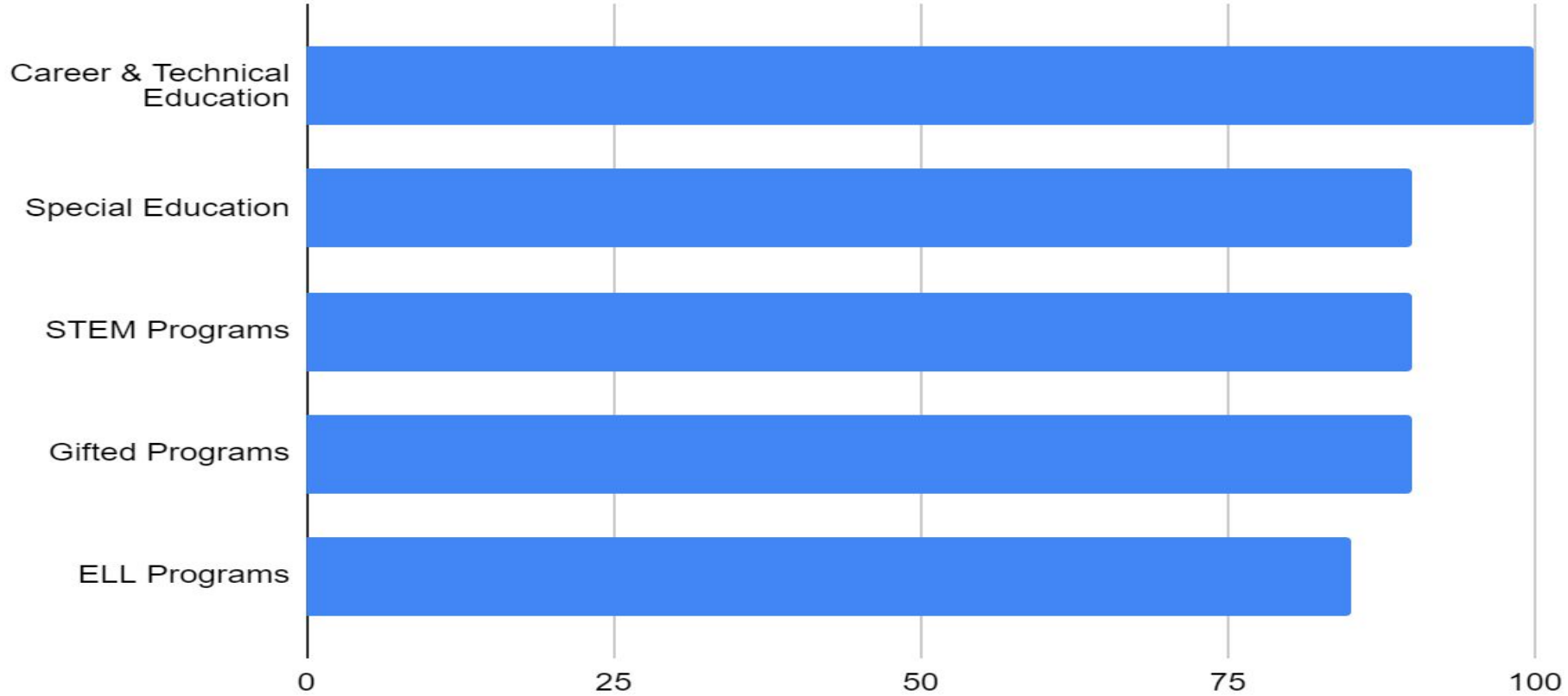
# Count of How important is investing in Programs overall?

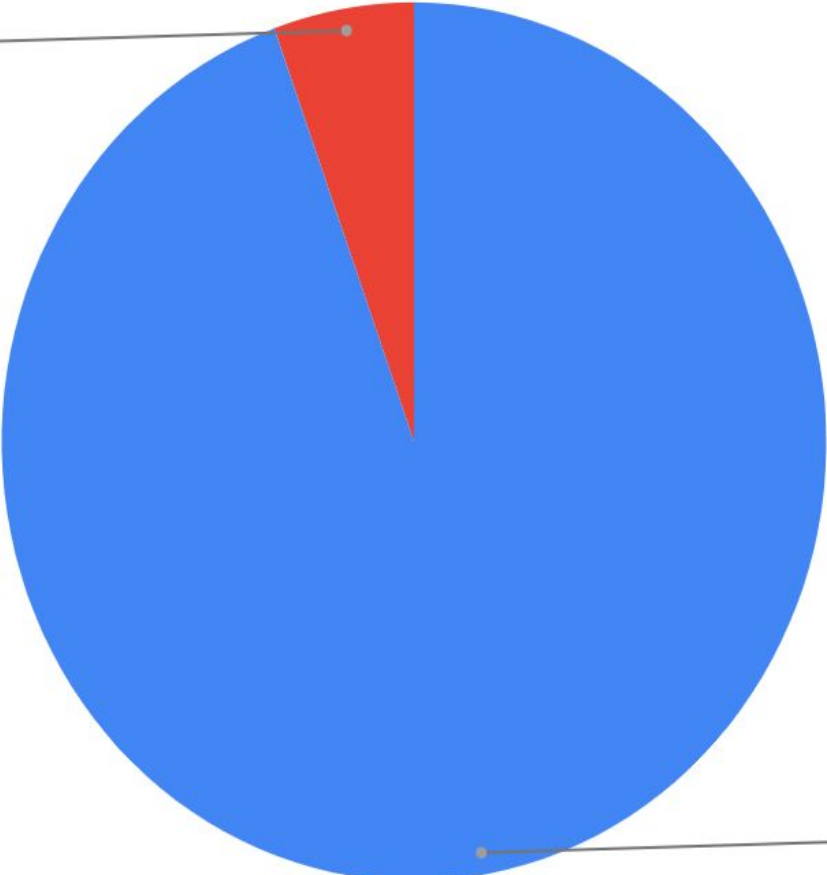
