#### VII. Student Representative Update

Hunter White gave a review of successful homecoming events. Student council raised approximately \$2,000 from the dance and has also received a contribution from the community. Clubs are beginning a food drive, toy drive and clothing drive during the holiday season. The supplies will be donated to Hope House, a new housing shelter in Sedona. Students are coordinating a Veteran's Day presentation with Mr. Vogler. The presentation will include former students enlisted in the armed services, veterans and community members.

#### VIII. Superintendent's Update

Denny Dearden

Mr. Dearden gave a thorough overview of happenings around the district. Covid cases have remained low. SOCUSD has enrolled 5 new students with much credit given to Heather Hermen and the successful PR campaign. At Sedona Red Rock Jr/Sr High School, students and staff had a great homecoming week with many fun events. Most fall sports have wrapped up. Mr. Dearden expressed thanks to the coaching staff for a successful season. Students in the Early College Program will travel to Yavapai College next week. This program is in the third year and helps the school to offer a wide range of options to students. Work has begun on next year's master schedule, with an emphasis on allowing students as many choices as possible. The new SEL counselor has started. At West Sedona School, the Wildcat Carnival raised approximately \$33,000

for the school. The Wildcat Kid's Club is in the hiring process to grow the program so that it can continue to serve the needs of our community. Mr. Dearden concluded by giving a special thanks to Sally Cadigan for her years of service with the district.

#### X. Business Items and Presentations

A. Review of proposed amendment to the ASBA Bylaws Karen McClelland Karen McClelland gave an overview of current ASBA Board of Directors. Currently, there is representation for many groups on the board. However, Hispanic and Native American communities rotate seats and do not have continuous representation. This amendment would add an additional board seat to correct this problem.

**ACTION ITEM:** Discussion and possible action to approve proposed amendment to Article V, Section 2(B) – Officers and Board of Directors and Executive Committee to create a seat on the ASBA Board of Directors so that Hispanic and Native American interests can be represented simultaneously on the board.

**B.** First reading of ASBA Policy Services Advisory Volume 33, Number 4

Karen McClelland

Karen McClelland stated that changes are the result of a recent AZ Supreme Court Decision that gave authority back to local school boards to make choices about mask mandates and removed financial penalties associated with teaching sensitive matters in the classroom. The changes are similar to items passed approximately two months ago by the SOCUSD board. The second reading and will occur in December.

C. Presentation from the City of Sedona regarding proposed rental of fenced field at West Sedona School for overflow park and ride transit parking.

City of Sedona staff and Police Chief Husted gave a detailed presentation regarding a lease of the fenced field at WSS to be used as a parking lot and trailhead shuttle location (see attached PowerPoint Presentation). Board members expressed a desire to be good partners with the city, but had questions regarding safety, crowds, traffic and maintenance. Mr. Hawley asked for the item to be placed on our December agenda, allowing time for board members to visit the site and city personnel to develop specific plans to address board member concerns.
